



1. Agentes Secretos y el Mural de Picasso

“*Secret Agents and Picasso’s Mural*” by Mira Canion



2. Movimientos Milagrosos by Jerry Trousdale

“*Miraculous Movements*”


This book recounts the amazing way Jesus Christ is introducing himself to and is transforming the lives of thousands within Muslim communities. Each chapter begins with an incredible story of God, followed by a closer look at key scriptural principles that help Christians reach out in love and service to others to share the gospel within their own communities.



3. Esperanza Renace by Pam Muñoz Ryan

“*Esperanza Rising*”

This riches to rags story recounts the life of a girl named Esperanza who had everything she ever wanted living on a ranch in Mexico until tragedy hits forcing her and her mother to flee to California where they settle in a camp for Mexican farm workers during the great depression. It recounts how Esperanza rises above her difficult circumstances to save her mother's life.



4. La Casa en Mango Street

“*The house on Mango Street*” by Sandra Cisneros

This story covers a year in the life of Esperanza, Mexican-American teenager who moves with her family into a house on Mango Street in a crowded latino neighborhood. Esperanza matures a lot during this year and the novel charts her life as she makes friends, grows hips, develops her first crush, endures sexual assault and begins to write as a way of expressing herself and as a way to escape the neighborhood.
