Notes about the required graphic calculator: If you do not want to pay full price for a new TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator, there are many used ones in good condition available online (such as ebay.com) for \$30 to \$40. If you are comfortable with buying one this way, just make sure to buy from a seller with good ratings, a good return policy, and choose a calculator that is stated to be in good condition. It does not matter which model or edition of TI-83 or TI-84 it is (regular, plus, silver, CE, etc.). However, the ones that use batteries have been around for a long time and have been shown to last a very long time (20+ years) while the ones that use a charger cable and have a color display (the CE models) have not been around long enough to know for sure if they will last as long or not.
