Parents and Seniors:

lowa Immunization law requires that all students entering, advancing, or transferring into 12th grade and born after September 15, 1999, will need proof of two doses of meningococcal (A, C W, Y) vaccine (1 does received on or after 16 years of age); OR only 1 dose, if it was received when the student was 16 years of age or older. One dose HAS to be received at 16 years of age or older. **Proof of this OR a Medical/Religious Exemption is required.**

Meningococcal disease is a life threatening illness that is caused by bacteria that infects the brain, blood and spinal cord. It easily spreads in crowded settings and typically affects older teens and young adults.

ALL students entering 12th grade must have proof of having the Meningococcal vaccine unless the student has a Certificate of Immunization Exemption.

Please contact your family healthcare provider or Public Health to make an appointment for your child to receive the Meningococcal vaccine. **Please return the Certificate of Immunization to the school as soon as possible. You can mail it, drop it off, or have it faxed to the school.**
