

Later in this packet you'll see how Hillcrest Academy student success compares to national averages. Those achievements are due to our strong academic rigor. Private education opens up many advantages for academic challenges and expectations that public schools can't match. Along with our 9 AP classes in various disciplines, Hillcrest students have opportunities such as Anatomy and Physiology which will challenge any budding scientist or medical student. Hillcrest Academy offers College Board-certified Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Current AP courses offered at Hillcrest include Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Statistics, US Government and Politics and US History.

Hillcrest partners with Kirkwood Community College to offer concurrent courses that allow students to earn college credit while still in high school, explore exciting career paths in Agriculture and Industrial Arts, and gain valuable hands-on skills in Animal Science, Small Engines Repair, and Welding Fundamentals

Our academic standards are high, and our faculty are passionate, engaged, mentors who know and love their students. The teachers and staff here live out another aspect of our academic foundation — we offer a distinctive Christian education at Hillcrest Academy. Our graduates are active, informed citizens who lead through discipleship, peacemaking, and service. 

Hillcrest Academy boasts a rigorous academic program that challenges young minds and cultivates a love for learning. Our dedicated faculty guide students through a comprehensive curriculum, nurturing critical thinking, problem-solving skills, and a thirst for knowledge.

But education at Hillcrest goes beyond textbooks. We believe in nurturing the whole person, fostering spiritual growth and a strong moral compass. Our Christian environment provides a supportive community where students can explore their faith, develop integrity, and learn to lead with compassion and purpose.

At Hillcrest Academy our High School Students:

- Explore their strengths and passions with guidance from dedicated counselors and a variety of assessments and experiences which allows them to examine options for their future in college, career or ministry.
- Graduate fully equipped for life beyond high school, boasting a 100% college acceptance rate and strong skills in academics, faith, and leadership.
- Learn in a nurturing environment with a 5:1 student-teacher ratio, where teachers are called by their first names and relationships are built on trust and respect.

- Compete in championship-winning athletics in a variety of sports, including baseball, basketball, cross-country, football, golf, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, track & field, volleyball, and wrestling.
- Discover their faith and develop a strong moral compass in a supportive Christian environment that fosters integrity, compassion, and leadership with purpose.
- Become well-rounded individuals through a vibrant tapestry of extracurricular activities, including athletics, the arts, robotics, and community service.

College Guidance and Scholarship

Since we have such a low teacher-to-school counselor ratio we provide significantly more support and personalized counseling than public high schools can afford to give. Each year, the counselor will meet with your student to review their college and career plans and check in to see what they are learning about God's plan for their life and gifts. They review grades, college placement tests, and college options that fit their needs and interests.

Scholarship opportunities are tremendously important to most students and families. Our counselors provide excellent assistance in this area. We have more than 100 targeted scholarships to review with rising juniors and seniors as well as critical resources for securing other funds.

We know our students and who God is shaping them to be. Helping them find the right schools or career paths to pursue with the financial assistance to support those goals is a big part of how we help prepare our graduates for whatever comes next.

Service and Learning Term (SALT)

Some of the most vital, life-long lessons Hillcrest Academy students learn happen outside of the classroom. Every other year, a group of students and faculty participate in our Service and Learning Term. It is a week where we live out our beliefs in challenging ways. We serve others, and it inevitably nurtures new growth in our students and community.

The SALT program encompasses diverse service initiatives. In recent years this included an international mission trip in Heredia, Costa Rica, where a group of 10 students experienced a condensed mission training program with Vida Net. A different group of students worked to aid in the reconstruction efforts in Dawson Springs, Kentucky, following the devastating tornadoes of 2021.

The SALT Music Team focused on developing a music program for retirement communities in the local area, while the Prairie Management/Natural Resource Conservation Work group engaged in trail maintenance and ecological restoration in various outdoor locations. The Urban Plunge in Omaha, Nebraska, partnered with Christ for the City International, participating in service ministries throughout the city, and exploring the Omaha Zoo.

Lastly, the HACAP and Crowded Closet group contributed to community service through volunteering at Crowded Closet in Iowa City and HACAP Food Reservoir in Hiawatha, undertaking tasks such as packing food for students in need and creating superhero capes for children in foster care. Each group is led by dedicated sponsors, fostering a meaningful blend of service, learning, and community engagement.
