English 1, 2 (Composition), English 3 (American Literature), AP English

3-ring binder (1") with pockets and notebook (dedicated for English class use ONLY)

Math Department:

Algebra I/IA/IB, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus

TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator (REQUIRED*), graph paper, pencils, notebook, and folder OR 3-ring binder and loose-leaf paper

Geometry

Scientific calculator or graphing calculator (REQUIRED*), graph paper, pencils, ruler, compass, protractor, notebook, and folder OR 3-ring binder and loose-leaf paper

**Note about the required graphing calculator: If you do not want to pay full price for a new TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator, there are many used ones in good condition available online (such as ebay.com) for \$30 to \$40. If you are comfortable with buying one this way, just make sure to buy from a seller with good ratings, check for a good return policy, and choose a calculator that is stated to be in good condition. It does not matter which model or edition of TI-83 or TI-84 it is (regular, plus, silver, CE, etc.), however, the ones that use batteries have been around for a long time and have been shown to last a very long time (20+ years) while the ones that use a charger cable and have a color display (the CE models) have not been around long enough to know for sure how long they will last.*

For Physics, a TI-83 or TI-84 calculator is recommended, especially if planning to study a STEM field in college. A TI-30XIIs will work if cost is an issue (The TI-30XIIs can be purchased at Walmart or Target for approximately \$15). **For Chemistry, a scientific calculator like the TI-30XIIs will be fine, or a graphing calculator like TI 83 or 84. A heavy-duty 3-inch binder for chemistry use only. Paper for taking notes, a set of dividers, pens, and colored pencils. Two boxes of alcohol swabs (Walmart has boxes of 100 for about \$1.25).**
